#### **Our Mission:**

To improve access to the court system and assure quality legal representation for clients regardless of income, ethnicity, or native language by providing legal education and representation to low-income clients who are in personal transition out of poverty toward safety and self-sufficiency.

#### **Our Vision:**

Families will achieve stability and build a successful future for themselves and their children.

#### **Our Background:**

For over 30 years, Centro Legal has provided free and low-cost legal assistance to thousands of Milwaukee low-income individuals and families facing a crisis. Our holistic approach helps our clients resolve complex issues, overcome obstacles and ultimately transition to a more stable and healthy family environment. We primarily provide family law and criminal misdemeanor defense services, both of which are areas that are highly personal, emotional, and with high stakes, particularly when children are involved. Our goal is to help our clients successfully navigate the legal system and obtain a successful resolution so that they can maintain employment, stabilize their families, and continue moving forward towards financial independence and self-sufficiency.

## **PROGRAMS:**

#### Family Law Program:

Centro Legal provides complete legal representation in family law matters, including restraining orders, child custody and placement, child support and divorce. These cases often involve serious issues regarding the safety and well-being of children. Over 60% of our family law clients are survivors of domestic abuse. In these cases, we provide specialized services and partner with domestic abuse advocates to ensure that our clients receive all the support they need during a transitional and emotional period in their lives. In 2021, we provided representation in 172 family law cases for clients who are parents to 287 children in their households.

#### Domestic Violence Family Law Program:

Over the last fifteen years, we have developed a particular specialty in providing legal advice and representation to survivors of domestic abuse. In fact, the majority of our family law clients have experienced abuse. In this program, we are able to provide free legal assistance to resolve all the family law issues beyond a restraining order. These issues are critical for the family to establish a new family

foundation that is safe, strong and consistent. Within this program, we work collaboratively with several domestic abuse shelters and programs so that our clients receive holistic support to support the transition from abuse to independence. In 2021, we provided free representation to 115 domestic abuse survivors and consulted with many more to give legal advice and guidance.

## Criminal Law Program:

Centro Legal represents individuals who do not qualify for public defender representation but cannot afford to hire a private attorney. To qualify for public defender representation, the income requirements are set at 115% of the federal poverty guidelines, leaving a significant gap in legal support for those with low and modest incomes. In most cases, we represent our clients in diversions or deferred prosecution agreements. Our legal support can help these individuals remain in the community, stay employed and address substance abuse or other concerns during their cases. In 2021, we provided representation in 18 misdemeanor cases.

#### Guardian ad Litem (GAL) Program:

The courts appoint Centro Legal to represent the best interests of children and minor parents in family and paternity cases. We are appointed as GALs for most of the minor fathers in Milwaukee County who must interact with the court system to establish paternity and parental rights. We also represent children in custody and placement cases. In 2021, we represented the best interests of children and minor parents in 186 cases.

## Consultation Program:

In addition to our full representation services, we provide legal advice and information through our consultation program. Cento Legal provides in-depth legal consultations for people with family law concerns. We help individuals understand their court orders and complete their paper work, prepare individuals to represent themselves, deter inappropriate or ill-timed claims and provide referrals to community resources. Since most people must face the family court system without an attorney, we seek to prepare as many people as we can to represent themselves effectively. In 2021, we provided 718 legal consultations.

#### Annual Event – Centro LeGala

The challenges of the Covid-19 pandemic led us to host our second virtual gala in 2021, where we celebrated the impact of our services with a virtual program, silent auction, and wine pull.
